

### **Beacon Conference Group Submission Guidelines**

- Students who worked as a group to complete a project are welcome to present their work at the Beacon Conference.
- Student work must be presented in a poster format.
  - Group presentations will take place during the afternoon poster session.
  - Guidelines suggesting how to prepare a poster are available on the Beacon Conference web page under the “Guidelines” tab.
- The Group Submission category is a non-competitive category.
  - Projects will not be judged during the conference.
  - Every member of the group will receive a Certificate of Participation.
- To submit group work, students must:
  - Submit their work by the deadline indicated on the Submit tab of the Beacon web page.
  - Submit consists of either:
    - A paper written by the group or
    - A 200-300 word abstract describing the project with a reference page
